On May 23, a delegation of North Carolina Bar Association members will travel to Taiwan at the invitation of the Taiwan Bar Association. The trip, designed as a cultural and legal exchange, will include stays in the major cities of Taiwan (Taipei, Hsinchu, Taichung and Kaohsiung); informative meetings for CLE credit with members of the judiciary, government, and private firms; and business development opportunities.

In May 2007, a delegation of attorneys from Taiwan will come to North Carolina for a reciprocal program.
