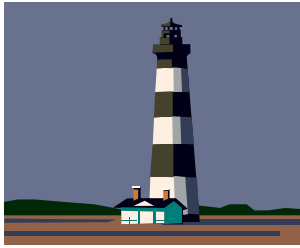

A former newspaper reporter, Frank is full of stories about this historic and ecologically important island. Or, if you prefer, bring a blanket and just relax on the beach. Historic Beaufort Tour and site visit

Hop aboard and see Beaufort's historic district from atop a 1967 English double-decker bus. Local narrators tell tales of Beaufort's rich past of pirates, star-crossed lovers, and Confederate spies. All prized for their period collections and furnishings, the homes of history run the gamut from the rustic c1778 [Leffers Cottage](#), and the elaborately furnished Victorian [Josiah Bell House c1825](#), to the award-winning restoration of the Federal-style [John C. Manson House c1825](#). The historic buildings include the [Carteret County Jail c1829](#), the [Apothecary Shop and Doctor's Office c1857](#) containing priceless pharmaceutical and medicinal artifacts used in early Beaufort, and the [Carteret County Courthouse of 1796](#), which is the only remaining wood-framed English Circuit courthouse left intact in North Carolina. Each building depicts a different period or aspect of life in historic Beaufort. After the tour, feel free to visit the intriguing OLD Burying Ground, or the NC Maritime Museum, all within easy walking distance. *No cost to you; paid for by sponsors
