- c. helped forward the discussion and debate of constitutional issues by the public and/or the profession.

### **Eligibility:**

A citizen residing in the State of North Carolina.

#### **Nomination Process:**

- 1. A nomination may be made by any member in good standing of the North Carolina Bar Association.
- 2. The award selection shall be made by the Nominations Committee of the Executive Council of the Constitutional Rights & Responsibilities Section of the North Carolina Bar Association.
- 3. The award will be presented at the Constitutional Rights & Responsibilities Section Annual Meeting.

Attach additional sheets of  $(8\frac{1}{2} \times 11)$  paper as needed for your answers. (Limit to two additional pages and please do not include any other supporting documents.) Please note that the nominee will be asked to confirm information provided.
